Please be advised that the Philadelphia Area Industrial Energy Users Group ("PAIEUG") will not be submitting Exceptions to the Recommended Decision ("R.D.") of Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Christopher P. Pell issued on April 12, 2021, in the above-referenced proceeding.

Although PAIEUG has no exceptions regarding the substance of the R.D., PAIEUG observed one administrative issue within the R.D. that it seeks to bring to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") attention. The R.D. adopted the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement's ("I&E's") revenue allocation presented in I&E's Surrebuttal Testimony. R.D. at 406. However, the revenue allocation chart included in the R.D. does not reflect the minor corrections made by I&E in a subsequent Errata filing on February 16, 2021. The Final Order should include the corrected chart from I&E's Errata filing.
