An Interim Order Postmarked April 22, 2021 was received today that required a “Status Report” in the above-captioned matter

AND NOW, in receipt today of the April 22, 2021 postmarked “Interim Order” Complainant files the forgoing.

1. Nothing has changed with Duquesne Light’s “suspect” billing behavior.
2. To begin, Duquesne Light Company says it received a \$196.56 cash grant from LIHEAP on April 7, 2021.
3. However, on March 31, 2021 “LIHEAP 1” had awarded \$853.00 in addition to the “LIHEAP 2” \$196.56 “crisis cash grant.”

4. In addition, neither the “LIHEAP 1” award of \$853.00 or the “LIHEAP 2” \$196.56 “crisis cash grant” is listed on the April 25, 2021 billing statement requesting \$359.44.
5. Lastly, a knowingly misleading “postcard” in Duquesne Light’s name was received “advising” the complainant’s wife Kellie Dillard that she is the recipient of a \$100 Visa Gift Card for “selecting” SmartEnergy electricity supply???
