(b) On September 18, 1985, the Borough of Ridley Park, in Delaware County, filed the instant complaint alleging that the approach slabs and deck of the bridge carrying Sellers Avenue over the railroad tracks were in a state of disrepair. Hearings were held on September 18, 1986 and May 28, 1987.

On April 21, 1988, the Commission adopted the Recommended Decision of ALJ Martin R. Fountain, issued February 4, 1988, which directed PennDOT to rehabilitate the highway approaches and deck of the subject bridge and allocated maintenance responsibility therefor. By letter received August 22, 1991, Borough of Ridley Park informed the Commission that the ordered work was satisfactorily completed in June 1991.
