PREHEARING MEMORANDUM OF COLUMBIA GAS OF PENNSYLVANIA, INC.

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MARK A. HOYER:

I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

This Memorandum is in response to the Prehearing Conference Order, dated May 10, 2021, advising that a Prehearing Conference is scheduled for May 17, 2021, in the above-referenced matter.

On March 30, 2021, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia") filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Supplement No. 325 to its Tariff Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 ("Supplement No. 325" or "base rate filing"). Supplement No. 325 was issued to be effective for service rendered on or after May 29, 2021. It proposed changes to Columbia's distribution base rates designed to produce an increase in annual revenues of approximately \$98.3 million based upon data for a fully projected future test year ("FPFTY") ending December 31, 2022. The filing was made in compliance with the Commission's regulations, and contains all supporting data and testimony required to be submitted in conjunction with a tariff change seeking a general rate increase.

On May 6, 2021, the Commission issued an Order suspending Columbia's Supplement No. 325 by operation of law until December 29, 2021.¹

On April 7, 2020 the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement filed a Notice of Appearance. Complaints were filed by the Office of Consumer Advocate (April 6, 2021), Office of Small Business Advocate (April 15, 2021), Columbia Industrial Intervenors (April 29, 2021), and the Pennsylvania State University (May 7, 2021). Petitions to Intervene were filed by the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (April 12, 2021), Shipley Choice, LLC and Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. (April 16, 2021), and Pennsylvania Weatherization Providers Task Force (May 3, 2020).
