Enclosed please find the Electric Generation Supplier (EGS) License Application ("Application") for TFS Energy Solutions, LLC d/b/a Tradition Energy ("Applicant.")

Applicant respectfully requests expedited service of this Application as Applicant's license Number A-2009-2132890 was recently cancelled due to a mailing error (Applicant timely filed via email its Bond Continuation Certificate with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") but Applicant's insurance carrier did not mail a hard copy of the Bond to the Commission due to the pandemic). Prior to cancellation, Applicant was a broker licensed in Pennsylvania in good standing since 2009 without any complaints or missed filings. Applicant also respectfully requests that the Publication requirements set forth in the Application be waived because of Applicant's prior good standing status, loss of license due to a good faith mistake and also due to the fact that Applicant is seeking licensing as a broker and not an electricity supplier that takes title to electricity.






