PETITION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.71, 5.72 and 5.74, Valley Township ("Valley" or the "Township"), by and through its attorneys, Obermayer Rebmann Maxwell & Hippel LLP, hereby files with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") this Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned Application of Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") for approval of (1) the transfer, by sale, of substantially all of Valley Township's assets, properties and rights related to its wastewater collection and conveyance system to PAWC, and (2) the rights of PAWC to begin to offer or furnish wastewater service to the public in Valley Township, and limited portions of East Fallowfield Township, Sadsbury Township and West Caln Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania

The Application directly affects the interests of Valley, which are not adequately represented by any existing party. For the reasons that follow, Valley respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene, and in support thereof avers as follows:

- Valley is a Township of the Second Class located in Chester County,
 Pennsylvania.
 - 2. Valley's business address is 1145 West Lincoln Highway, Coatesville, PA 19320.
- 3. Valley owns, operates and maintains the Township's wastewater collection and conveyance system (the "Wastewater System"), which consists of a sanitary wastewater collection and conveyance system made up of approximately thirty-nine (39) miles of interceptors, force mains, and tributary collection sewers. Collected wastewater is transmitted to the treatment plant owned by PAWC in Coatesville, Pennsylvania (the Coatesville District Wastewater Treatment Plant). The Wastewater System collects and conveys sanitary wastewater from Township residents, as well as some residents of West Caln Township, Sadsbury Township and East Fallowfield Township.
- 4. Valley is interested in the above-captioned docket as a party to the agreement under which PAWC seeks approval to acquire Valley's assets, properties and rights related to its Wastewater System.
 - 5. Valley supports the Application filed by PAWC at this docket.
- 6. 52 Pa. Code § 5.72 sets forth the eligibility requirements for a party to intervene and provides in part as follows:
 - (a) Persons. A petition to intervene may be filed by a person claiming a right to intervene or an interest of such nature that intervention is necessary or appropriate to the administration of the statute under which the proceeding is brought. The right or interest may be one of the following:
 - (1) A right conferred by statute of the United States or of the Commonwealth:

- (2) An interest which may be directly affected and which is not adequately represented by existing participants, and as to which the petitioner may be bound by the action of the Commission in the proceeding;
- (3) Another interest of such nature that participation of the petitioner may be in the public interest.
- 7. Valley seeks intervention in the proceeding for due cause shown for the following reasons:
 - (a) Valley is a party to the Asset Purchase Agreement (the "APA") for its Wastewater System, which serves approximately 3,164 customers. The Wastewater System collects and conveys sanitary wastewater from Township residents, as well as 30 residents of West Caln Township, Sadsbury Township and East Fallowfield Township;
 - (b) As contemplated in the APA, Valley will be the recipient of the proceeds of the sale of its Wastewater System; and
 - (c) PAWC's Application relies on Valley's consent to the sale of the Wastewater System.
- 8. Valley has a substantial and bona fide interest in the subject matter of this docket and its interests cannot be represented or protected adequately by other existing parties to this docket.
- 9. As a party to the APA and the recipient of the proceeds from the sale of the Wastewater System, Valley submits that its intervention is in the public interest.
- 10. Valley intends to play an active role in the Commission's decision-making process and its participation herein will not unduly prejudice any party.

WHEREFORE Valley respectfully requests that the Commission grant the instant

Petition to Intervene in this proceeding.
