MOTION OF PECO ENERGY COMPANY FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSES TO THE COMMISSION’S TENTATIVE ORDER

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(a)(1), PECO Energy Company (“PECO” or “Company”) files this Motion for an Extension of Time to file responses in the above-captioned proceeding.

On May 6, 2021, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“the Commission”) issued a Tentative Order requesting that PECO provide greater detail regarding more than two dozen items covering seventeen distinct topics. The Tentative Order allowed for PECO’s response to be submitted within 20 days of entry of the Order (or by May 26, 2021).

The Commission may extend the deadline for performing an act if a motion that demonstrates good cause for the extension is filed prior the expiration of the period in question. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(a)(1). PECO has been working diligently to address the issues raised by the Commission in

its Tentative Order, however, due to the number of data requests and the multiple queries required to perform most of the data analytics, the Company will be unable to compile all the information needed for its responses prior to the May 26, 2021 deadline. Accordingly, PECO requests that the Commission extend the deadline for the Company to file responses for a period of 15 days (or until June 10, 2021).

Please note that due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, PECO's office personnel are working remotely. Accordingly, PECO will not have its usual access to photocopying and U.S. mail, among other services. PECO requests that all communications with PECO be transmitted by email.
