

Attached are updates for 388<sup>th</sup> Revised Page 2, 138<sup>th</sup> Revised Page 2-B, 49<sup>th</sup> Revised Page 6-A, 1<sup>st</sup> Revised Page 70-S, Original Page 70-S-1, and 1<sup>st</sup> Revised Page 70-T for Mountain Movers, LLC (PA PUC #A-8919760) in Mohnton PA. This filing is an INCREASE in their local hourly rates (Non-Peak Season and Peak Season), a CHANGE in the minimum transportation charges, the ADDITION of an overnight holding fee, a CHANGE in the verbiage for travel time charges, an INCREASE in the cost of containers, and the ADDITION of packing and unpacking per container charges in lieu of rates in Tristate 50-T and Tristate 51-W. The Issue Date is May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021, and the Effective Date for these exceptions in Tariff 54 is June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
