Re: Broker Requirements


Dear Breakerbox, LLC:

PECO is aware that Breakerbox, LLC has applied for a license to provide brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers on the distribution system of PECO.

In making such an application, Breakerbox, LLC could be required to provide to PECO a bond or other acceptable financial security in an amount that PECO determines to be appropriate. Breakerbox, LLC has indicated that it intends to provide only brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers, and will not take title to any delivered natural gas; nor will accept any customer payments or deposits. Therefore, PECO has determined at this time that Breakerbox, LLC does not need a bond or other financial security requirement, since they are not directly engaging in business with PECO and only providing brokering or consulting services to PECO customers. However, if the services provided by Breakerbox, LLC the creditworthiness requirement for PECO's exposure to Breakerbox, LLC changes in the future, PECO reserves the right to require Breakerbox, LLC to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.
