OPERATING AUTHORITY

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons, in limousine service, between points in Pennsylvania, excluding service between points in Allegheny County, and services under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Advance reservations must be made for services.
2. Rates and charges are computed from the time when the vehicle leaves the nearest equipment availability point until the vehicle returns to said point.
3. Equipment will be made available to patrons on a non-discriminatory basis, first come first serve.
4. Nothing in this tariff shall be construed as requiring Good Fellas Limousine Service to furnish service for which it does not have suitable or sufficient equipment available. Good Fellas Limousine Service is not bound to furnish service for any particular airline schedule. Good Fellas Limousine Service will provide service with reasonable dispatch in the order of the call for service. Good Fellas Limousine Service shall not be required to travel over roads which it deems dangerous, inadequate or impossible.
5. Unless otherwise specified, time shall be computed in terms of hours calculated to the next hour. On garage to garage service, where the passenger is transported one way, the time shall be twice the one way time.
6. The charges herein named do not include bridge, turnpike, tunnel, ferry fees, or similar tolls and charges or gratuities unless otherwise noted in this tariff. Such additional fees, tolls and charges must be paid by the patron, in addition to all other charges.
7. Baggage and other personal effects, such as may be transported in the vehicle at the same time as the patron, will be transported at no extra charge.
8. Upon presentation of a dated newspaper advertised coupon, or other promotional consideration, Good Fellows Limousine will offer rates at a specified discount from the published tariff rates, on the dates authorized by the coupon. Any advertised coupon will be filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission prior to newspaper publication.
9. Good Fellows Limousine reserves the right to cancel any reservation for service. Pre-paid reservations will be refunded in full.

Rules and Regulations (continued)

10. Good Fellows Limousine reserves the right to refuse transportation to any individual(s) under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or who is incapable of taking care of himself or herself or who shows conduct which is otherwise objectionable.
11. Good Fellows Limousine will provide service for passengers on the following days at 1½ times the appropriate regular rate:
 - a. Christmas Eve Day after 12 noon
 - b. Christmas Day
 - c. New Year's Eve Day
 - d. New Year's Day
 - e. Easter
 - f. Memorial Day
 - g. July 4
 - h. Labor Day
 - i. Thanksgiving Day
12. Patrons will be responsible for the return of vehicle(s) to Good Fellows Limousine in substantially the same condition as presented at the onset of travel. Vehicle(s) returned in excessively dirty and/or damaged condition shall be assessed a fee of the actual cost for any cleaning, maintenance and/or repairs to restore the condition of the vehicle(s) as presented at the onset of travel.
13. Good Fellows Limousine will not be responsible for delays occasioned by acts of God, public enemies, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to a state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, storms, and other conditions beyond its control and does not guarantee to arrive or depart from any point at a specific time.
14. A fifteen percent (15%) Driver Gratuity will be assessed in addition to all other published rates and charges.
15. Cellular telephone usage is subject to actual charges including air time and applicable toll charges.

Schedule of Rates

Eight Passenger Stretch Limousine

An Eight Passenger Stretch Limousine is an extended wheelbase vehicle that accommodates eight (8) passengers, excluding the driver and is equipped with a partitioned passenger compartment, ice chest, beverage center, electronic divider, television, VCR, AM/FM CD player.

First two hours or fraction thereof	\$ 160.00
Each additional ½ hour or fraction thereof	\$ 40.00

Six Passenger Limousine Service

A luxury sedan equipped with air conditioning and other amenities, designed to accommodate six passengers excluding the driver.

First hour or fraction thereof	\$ 75.00
Each additional ½ hour or fraction thereof	\$ 37.50
