MOTION FOR A FORMAL DISPOSITION OF THE CASE


And now comes, Claimant filing this request for closure as follows:

1. In January of 2020, Claimant filed a formal complaint with the PUC.
2. On 10/5/2020, a telephone hearing was held with an ALJ.
3. On 10/27/2020, an Interim Order for briefing was filed.
4. From 11/16-12/16/2020 all briefings were submitted onto the docket.
5. However, from 12/16/2020 through today 5/28/2021, there has been no activity whatsoever by the PUC with regards to the closure of the Complaint.

The Docket shows there has been no activity by the PUC since 12/16/2020 which was the last filing on the docket.

As a result, Claimant is requesting a formal disposition from the ALJ DeVoe, to please allow closure of this Formal Complaint as she has waited now from January, 2020 through May 2021, [approximately 485+ days], or for some kind of status update as to why there has been no further action.
