

We are filing for a modification to the \$250,000 requirement, in the amount of \$10,000. See Appendix G for the original bond in the amount of \$10,000. In support of the lower bond value, we submit that Applicant will not take title to any electricity transactions and will not pay electricity bills on behalf of our customers. Moreover, Applicant has demonstrated an excellent record of performance as a broker/marketer in the jurisdictions where we have participated in energy re-regulation back to 2003. We have never received a formal complaint in any jurisdiction, from any customer or EGS company that we have worked with. Applicant maintains a superb record of customer retention, exceeding 95% since the founding of our company in 2003.

CRITICAL BONDING NOTES:

Applicant is required to maintain a bond or other financial instrument the entire time it maintains an EGS license with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. If Applicant's security instrument is not continuous, Applicant <u>MUST</u> submit a Rider, Amendment, or Continuation Certificate annually based on the expiration date of its security instrument.

 - We have strong knowledge of distributed energy generation, including solar, wind, renewable natural gas and backup generation.
