**SUPPLEMENTAL DETAILED STATUS REPORT OF
HIDDEN VALLEY UTILITY SERVICES, L.P.**

AND NOW COMES Hidden Valley Utility Services, L.P. (“HVUS”) to update the Detailed Status Report it filed in this matter on March 1, 2021.

In support whereof, HVUS avers as follows:

1. The water treatment plant was inspected on or about May 28, 2021 for the purpose of issuing a Certificate of Occupancy. HVUS management was told that the Certificate of Occupancy will be mailed to the property owner (HVUS leases the property on which the water treatment plant is located). HVUS is in the process of obtaining a copy of the Certificate of Occupancy from the property owner and will file it at this docket.

2. HVUS and its outside engineer have submitted documentation to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (“DEP”) for the issuance of an “Operations of Facilities” permit. See **Appendix A**.

3. DEP personnel must inspect the water treatment plant, approve it and issue a “Certificate of Facilities” permit before HVUS can place the water treatment plant into service. At this time, it is unknown when DEP will inspect the water treatment plant and issue the permit. When the permit is issued, HVUS will file a copy at this docket.

4. No additional governmental approvals other than those discussed above are necessary for the construction or operation of the water treatment plant.

WHEREFORE, Hidden Valley Utility Services, L.P. respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale admit this Supplemental Detailed Status Report and Appendix A into the record in these proceedings.
