## TEMPORARY ACCESS ROAD AGREEMENT

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS**, That Lehigh-Northampton Airport Authority, herein after referred to as (Grantor) with an address of 3311 Airport Road, Allentown, Pennsylvania 18109 (Property), for the consideration of One Thousand One Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$1,150.00), do hereby, grant and convey unto PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, hereinafter referred to as (PPL), the right, liberty and privilege of constructing, maintaining and using a temporary access roadway, as shown on the plan hereto attached and made a part here of; located in the Borough of Catasauqua and in the Township of Hanover, County of Lehigh, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in Deed Book 1179 Page 308, and Deed Book 1186 Page 137, and Deed Book 1228 Page 280, for the purpose of free ingress, egress and regress to and for said PPL, its successors, assigns, lessees, licensees, tenants, agents, workmen, employees, contractors and subcontractors, together with necessary motor vehicles, equipment and other apparatus at all times **for a period not to exceed (6) months, being at the start of the PPL maintenance project and generally 16 feet in width, extending northwesterly off E. Race Street through properties with the Grantor** as required for the construction and maintenance activities of a PPL transmission facility; also the right to cut down and trim any trees, brush or other undergrowth upon, along or adjacent to said temporary access roadway which in the judgment of said PPL, may at any time interfere with the construction, maintenance or use of said temporary access roadway.

PPL agrees that it will repair any damage to the Property that was a direct result of this Agreement and restore the Property to its prior condition within a reasonable period of time upon completion of its construction and maintenance activities.

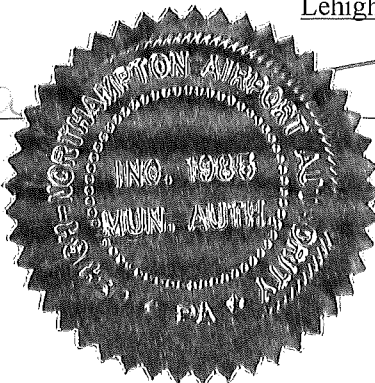
**This Agreement is between a public utility and a municipal corporation and is therefore subject to Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") review pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S.A. § 507. The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be the later of i) thirty (30) days from the date that PPL submits the Agreement to the PUC; or ii) if the PUC opens an investigation of the Agreement, on the date the PUC approves the Agreement.**
