RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Advance reservations are required and must be made twenty-four (24) hours prior to service being rendered. Any reservation made less than twenty-four (24) hours to travel time will be charged an additional fee. For any rides requiring will-call reservations, services must schedule a will-call reservations twenty-four (24) hours prior to pick-up. Final confirmations for will-call rides must be confirmed three (3) hours prior to pick-up time.
2. Rates for mileage are determined by the odometer of the vehicle in use and begin when the vehicle leaves the passenger's premises. The final mileage reading is determined upon drop-off of the passenger.
3. Additional expenses necessitated by or incurred at the request of the passengers, including but not limited to, highway tolls, bridge tolls, entrance fees and parking, shall be added to the charge of the trip. Expenses for driver's lodging and meals while on trips out of town which are in excess of ten (10) hours will be added to the basic charge.
4. If any trip requires the vehicle and driver to remain at a destination overnight, or at any point en route to a destination overnight, the patron will be responsible for providing carrier's driver with accommodations at an overnight facility (motel, hotel) being utilized by the patron, and all meals required by the carrier's driver. Expenses for driver's lodging and meals while on trips out of town which are in excess of ten (10) hours will be added to the basic charge.
5. Trips on the following Holidays are subject to Additional fees as listed in RATES:
 - New Year's Eve and New Year's Day
 - Memorial Day
 - Independence Day Labor Day
 - Thanksgiving Day and Black Friday (Day after Thanksgiving)
 - Christmas Eve and Christmas Day
 - Easter Sunday
 - Mother's Day Father's Day
6. Deposit: All reservations require a deposit of not more than 20% of the quoted charter price.
 - a. Deposits are subject to forfeiture the deposit if the charter is cancelled by the customer less than twenty-four (24) hours before the transportation was to depart.
 - b. Deposits are subject to forfeiture of not more than the total amount of the deposit if the cancellation occurs within 15 days prior to the date the transportation was to depart.
7. **CONTRACT SERVICES**

Contract services will be for a term of not less than 30 days for pre-qualified persons under a federal, state, county or municipal government agency contract. Rates for the services will be specified in the respective contracts, copies of which, including any

amendments thereto, are to be filed with the Commission as executed to become effective on one day's notice.

SCHEDULE OF RATES
(Per Person)

Flat Rates – For all loaded miles from the point of pickup to point of drop-off (one way)

Standard Hours: 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM

One-Way Ambulatory Van: \$45.00

One-Way Wheelchair Van: \$55.00

Evening Hours: 6:00 PM to 8:00 AM

One-Way Ambulatory Van: \$48.00

One-Way Wheelchair Van: \$58.00

Weekend Hours: Saturday 12:01 AM to Monday 7:59 AM

One-Way Ambulatory Van: \$50.00

One-Way Wheelchair Van: \$60.00

Holidays: 12:01 AM to 11:59 PM

One-Way Ambulatory Van: \$55.00

One-Way Wheelchair Van: \$65.00

Mileage rate: \$3.00 per mile, or any fraction thereof, applies in addition to the Flat Rate stated above on all loaded miles, after the first ten (10) miles, from the point of pick-up to the final destination.

Reservations: Any Reservation made less than twenty-four (24) hours before travel time will be charged an additional \$25.00 fee. Any will-call confirmations made less than three (3) hours before travel time will be charged an additional \$25.00 fee.

Waiting Time At Origin: After the first five (5) minutes of free time the passenger will be charged at the rate of \$1.00 for every (1) minute increment; however, after five (5) minutes, the driver can make the decision to depart from the pick-up location.

Waiting Time During Trip: If the driver is requested to wait for a customer at the destination or during a trip, there will be an additional waiting time charge of \$5.00 for every ten (10) minute increment, or any fraction thereof.

Extra Attendant: An extra attendant shall be provided by reservation in those instances where necessary, according to the passenger's needs or condition. The charge for the extra attendant is \$20.00 per trip and an additional \$10.00 per half hour, or any fraction thereof, after the first thirty (30) minutes from Pick Up Time.
