



- 3) The lot and office will be located 6350 Saybrook Ave Phila Pa 19142 which will house an office with a computer, fax and phone line, 2way radio to communicate with the drivers, the lot is enclosed and able to store up to six vehicles. I have an on-site mechanic to do preventive maintenance every 3000 miles, and yearly Pennsylvania emission and state inspection, every driver will do a pre and post trip inspection daily which will be uploaded and stored on the office computer, I will use a broker and the name of the companies are LogistiCare and Access 2 care for my customer request for pick up. the dispatcher will receive the trips and put together a daily schedule and email to all drivers, the cell phone and Motorola two-way radios, and GPS trackers will stay in contact with every driver.
- 4) **A.** All drivers will have a current drivers license with no suspension within the last 3 years, a clean criminal background, all drivers must be 21 yrs. and older and pass a drug screening.
B. The company I use to conduct the criminal background check is directscreening.com, for drug screening I use LabCorp and CVS
C. My driver training program consist of MAVO training Motor Assistance Vehicle Operation which is a 3day on the road training of proper vehicle techniques, vehicle knowledge and safety, we also have a CPR and OSHA trainer (Kareemah Manick) to come in and certify all drivers, all drivers are given a handbook of all company procedures and policies after their training.

D. All driver's license checks are conducted through www.dmv.pa.gov and drivers are subjected to DMV assessment every 6 months.

E. There is a zero tolerance drug and alcohol policy and all drivers are subjected to random drug testing.

6) My vehicle safety program consist of Pre and Post trip inspections, 3000 mile preventative maintenance, (oil change, tire rotation, brake inspection according to vehicle manufacture recommendations) Keep maintenance schedules in vehicle glove box which are completed by mechanic and signed each time the vehicle is serviced. Drivers are required to record pre and post trip milage daily and any vehicle problems are to be notated and signed off by the mechanic.

My continuous compliance will consist of all inspections required by the state.

7) I have received quotes from all state , Liberty Mutual and First Chicago Ins the quotes are between \$8,000 and \$12,000 a year per vehicle with 20% down and a monthly payment between \$700 and \$1,100 per month per vehicle.
