3. Reading Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad is a freight and passenger railroad serving over 50 customers in 9 counties throughout Pennsylvania. RBMN would like to reactivate the line where the subject crossing is located.

4. Reading Blue Mountain and Northern wishes to alter the said crossing by uncovering the pre-existing rails in the crossing, removing the tracks out of service signs, and restoring the cantilever-mounted flashing warning lights to active service. The flashing lights are currently hooded to indicate they are not in operation.

5. PennDOT and Muhlenburg Township as well as any other utilities in the vicinity of the crossing may be affected by this alteration.

6. 7. RBMN is willing to assume the costs associated with the work they would like to perform at the crossing. Costs will need to be determined at a later date when the full scope of work is determined.

8. The alteration is necessary for the following reasons: RBMN has a common carrier obligation to serve the needs of current and potential customers on our lines.

§ 1.36. Verification.




