Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to the Commission's December 22, 2010 Order in the above-referenced docket number granting Petition for Limited Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier, Assurance Wireless USA, L.P. ("Assurance Wireless") hereby notifies the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission of a change to its existing Assurance Wireless Lifeline offer.

As of July 15, 2021, Assurance Wireless will no longer offer a voice-only plan of 1000 domestic voice minutes and unlimited texts to new customers. Existing Lifeline smartphone customers on a voice-only plan will receive Assurance Wireless' bundled plan offering which includes 4.5 GB of data, 1000 voice minutes and unlimited texts at no charge to the customer. Customers will continue to receive the same amount of voice minutes and unlimited texts under the bundled plan offering as they did on the voice-only offering with the added benefit of 4.5 GB of data at no charge.
