Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(a)(1), PECO Energy Company (“PECO” or “Company”) files this **Motion for an Extension of Time to file Reply Comments** in the above-captioned proceeding. This Motion is supported by the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”), the Tenant Union Representative Network (“TURN”) and the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (“CAUSE-PA”).

By Secretarial Letter dated June 9, 2021, the Commission established a comment due date of July 20, 2021, with reply comments due 15 days thereafter (or by August 4, 2021).
