PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

On March 26, 1993, the Commission entered an Order remanding this case for those purposes set forth in Ordering Paragraphs 1 a. and b. thereof. In addition, the Commission ordered, inter alia, that no other matters are to be considered, and that the presiding Administrative Law Judge shall issue a supplemental decision concerning additional studies introduced and appropriate right-of-way width standards, if any within 120 days of the entry of the Commission's Opinion and Order (March 26, 1993).

- (d) List of, and copy of, every article, study or report prepared in whole or in part by that witness which concerns or relates to the issues potentially raised in this proceeding

As to witnesses who previously testified in this proceeding, if they or any of them are to testify in this remanded proceeding, then the information required in (a) through (d) above is to be updated.

Dear Judge Smolen:

This letter responds to Philadelphia Electric Company's ("PECO") letter dated May 3, 1993, in which PECO requests that you issue an order requiring all of the parties to this proceeding to explicitly state their positions on the two issues in this case on March 12, 1993.

Pennsylvania Power & Light Company ("PP&L"), as one of the parties who will not be submitting direct testimony on May 12, 1993, has considered PECO's request. It is PP&L's position that PECO's request is appropriate under the circumstances of this case. As you know, the issue of electric and magnetic fields ("EMF") involves particularly technical and complex scientific and policy issues, perhaps some of the most difficult faced by this Commission at the present time. Under such circumstances, it is important that all parties have the opportunity to present whatever responsive testimony is appropriate given the positions to be advanced by any of the parties to this proceeding. PP&L is taking this position even though PECO's request will require PP&L to undertake additional effort to state its formal position.



PP&L, however, does assume that when PECO requested that, in addition to a position, all parties be required to state "the facts relied upon for the position taken," PECO was referring to facts to be proven in evidence and not necessarily to legal or policy arguments to be made in support of a party's position. Such legal and policy arguments are frequently made in briefs and exceptions before this Commission, and although they may in some circumstances require certain facts in evidence, they do not always require such facts. PP&L believes that PECO was not requesting that a party be required to provide, in advance, all the legal and policy arguments which a party might make in briefs and exceptions. Such a "pre-brief" would not be appropriate in PP&L's opinion.

With this clarification, PP&L concurs with PECO's request that the parties' positions and supporting facts relied on be stated. Such a requirement will provide all parties, including PP&L, with sufficient knowledge of the positions to be taken by the various parties with regard to the two remanded issues in this proceeding, and will assist all parties in making rational decisions regarding responsive factual testimony.

In summary, PECO's request, in its letter dated May 3, 1993, should be granted expeditiously.


