- **4. Price and Billing: This is a fixed price agreement.** The fixed price that you will pay for electricity supply during the Initial Term of this Agreement is set forth on your Contract Summary. The prices will be effective starting with your first date of service with EcoPlus Power and will remain fixed for the Initial Term of this Agreement. The price for electricity generation supply may be higher or lower than the EDC's price in any particular month. Your price includes estimated total state taxes, but excludes Pennsylvania sales tax, if applicable. EcoPlus Power will calculate your supply charges for each billing period by multiplying (i) the price of electricity per kWh by (ii) the amount of electricity used during the billing period. This Agreement does not include your EDC's service and delivery charges.

- 5. Contract Length and Renewal: EcoPlus Power will begin providing your electricity generation beginning on the date set by your EDC. Your Agreement shall continue for the period set forth on the attached Contract Summary (the "Initial Term"). If you have a fixed duration contract that will be ending, or whenever EcoPlus Power wants to change the contract, you will receive two separate notices before the contract ends or the changes happen. You will receive the first notice 45-60 days before, and the second notice 30 days before the expiration date or the date the changes become effective. These notifications will explain your options. Unless another option is chosen, upon completion of the Initial Term, this Agreement will automatically renew on a month-to-month basis (the "Renewal Period") with no early termination fee under a variable rate. To the extent that you purchased a Renewable Plan at the time of enrollment, during the Renewal Period, the product you purchase and/or automatically will be provided, will not be a Renewable Energy Plan product.
- **6. Renewable Energy Plan:** If you are selecting our Renewable Energy Plan pursuant to this Agreement, you are agreeing to purchase from EcoPlus Power a product that is supported 100% by renewable energy credits ("RECs"), in an amount sufficient to match your annual consumption from your EDC, in addition to the mandatory renewable portfolio standard requirements for the state in which the Accounts are located, during the term of this agreement. The availability of electric generation facilities varies hour to hour, and from season to season, as does electricity use by customers. EcoPlus Power may take up to three (3) months following the close of a calendar year to make up any deficiency in the volume of renewable energy certificates needed from particular generation facilities associated with your Renewable Energy Plan.
- 7. Termination by Customer: Customer may terminate this Agreement at any time by contacting EcoPlus Power. If Customer terminates this Agreement and, as a result, effectively cancels service prior to the expiration of the Initial Term, an early termination fee mayapply, as stated in your Contract Summary. An early termination fee will not apply if you terminate this Agreement because you relocate outside of the Utility's service territory or to an area where EcoPlus Power charges a different price. If you terminate this Agreement, you will be returned to the EDC's default service unless you choose another retail supplier. The termination date will be determined as set forth in the EDC's tariff and applicable law. You will be obligated to pay for electricity and related services provided pursuant to this Agreement prior to the date that such termination becomes effective. If you terminate this Agreement by enrolling with a different retail supplier or returning to default service, EcoPlus Power will not be liable for any switching time delays and you will be obligated to make payment for services under this Agreement until termination of services from EcoPlus Power.
- 8. Termination by EcoPlus Power: EcoPlus Power reserves the right to terminate this Agreement for any reason upon by providing written notice to the Customer at the address provided. Common reasons for EcoPlus Power to cancel this agreement would include: Non-Payment If your electricity service is terminated by your EDC, then this agreement is cancelled on the date that your electric service is terminated. You will owe us for amounts unpaid for our charges for electricity generation service up to the date of termination. Customer Move If the customer moves from the address listed above, this agreement is cancelled. If we cancel this agreement for any reason other than for customer non-payment, we will follow applicable rules in providing notice to you. You will be obligated to pay for the electricity and related services provided pursuant to this Agreement prior to the date that such termination becomes effective. If EcoPlus Power terminates this Agreement early, you will be returned to your Utility's standard service unless you choose another retail supplier, without penalty.
- **9. Billing & Payment:** Your EDC will send you a consolidated bill for each Billing Cycle that will include your EDC's distribution charges, EcoPlus Power's electricity supply charges, any other charges incurred in accordance with the EDC's billing and payment terms. The amount of electricity used will be measured or estimated by the EDC. Depending on the date of the meter read, your bill may be prorated. You will make all payment directly to the EDC, and your payment will be due to the EDC by the date specified in the EDC bill. Any unpaid amounts may be subject to late payment charges. Your EDC maintains the right to terminate service for any unpaid utility or supplier charges, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's



regulations.

- **10. Assignment:** Subject to regulatory approvals and any required notice from EcoPlus Power, EcoPlus Power may assign this Agreement without your consent. EcoPlus Power may transfer or sell this Agreement or your account in connection with any financing. EcoPlus Power may also transfer this Agreement to any of its affiliates and assign this Agreement to anyone succeeding to all or substantially all of EcoPlus Power's assets or business and also transfer this Agreement to another supplier licensed by the Commission. After assignment, EcoPlus Power will have no further obligations under this Agreement. You may assign this Agreement only with EcoPlus Power's prior written consent.
- **11. Disputes:** You understand that EcoPlus Power will attempt to resolve any disagreement or complaint you may have. EcoPlus Power will refer all issues to a representative who in good faith will use reasonable efforts to reach a mutually satisfactory solution. If you are not satisfied after discussing your terms with us you may contact the Public Utility Commission (PUC) by phone at: 1-800-692-7380 or in writing at PO Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.
- 12. Waiver of Jury Trial. TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, ANY DISPUTE ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT, INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING IN CONTRACT, TORT, STATUTORY OR OTHERWISE, SHALL BE SETTLED EXCLUSIVELY AND FINALLY BY ARBITRATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. ANY ARBITRATION PROCEEDING HEREUNDER SHALL BE CONDUCTED EXCLUSIVELY IN PENNSYLVANIA. NEITHER PARTY MAY ALTER, AMEND, OR OTHERWISE CHANGE THE BINDING OBLIGATION TO ARBITRATE DISPUTES SET FORTH IN THIS PROVISION WITHOUT THE EXPRESS CONSENT OF THE OTHER PARTY. BY ENTERING INTO THIS AGREEMENT, CUSTOMER AGREES TO BINDING ARBITRATION AND WILL NOT PURSUE ANY FURTHER ACTION IN A COURT OF LAW. CUSTOMER WILL NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN A REPRESENTATIVE CAPACITY OR AS A MEMBER OF ANY CLASS OF CLAIMANTS PERTAINING TO ANY CLAIM SUBJECT TO ARBITRATION.
- **13. Force Majeure:** EcoPlus Power will make commercially reasonable efforts to provide your electric service, but does not guarantee a continuous supply of electricity. Certain causes and events out of EcoPlus Power's reasonable control may result in interruptions of service. EcoPlus Power will not be liable for any such interruptions or any other failure to perform under this Agreement caused by a Force Majeure Event. EcoPlus Power is not responsible for transmitting or distributing electricity. Therefore, you agree that EcoPlus Power is not, and shall not be, liable for damages caused by Force Majeure Events, including but not limited to. Acts of God, changes in law, rules, or regulations or other acts of any governmental authority (including the Commission of PJM as applicable), accidents, strikes, labor troubles, required maintenance work, inability to access the local distribution utility system, nonperformance by the EDC or any other cause beyond EcoPlus Power's reasonable control.
- **14. Information Release:** You authorize EcoPlus Power to obtain information from the EDC related to the account including without limitation account name, account number, billing address, service address, telephone number, service type, historical electricity usage, rate classification, meter readings, characteristics of electricity supply, and billing and payment information. These authorizations will remain in effect as long as the Agreement is in effect. You may rescind these authorizations at any time by either calling or providing written notice to EcoPlus Power at contact information provided. EcoPlus Power will maintain the confidentiality of the customer's personal information including name, address, phone number, usage, and payment history as required by applicable PUC regulations and Federal and State law, and will not release the customer's private confidential information to a third party without the customer's express consent.
- **15. Limitations of Liabilities:** LIABILITIES NOT EXCUSED BY REASON OF FORCE MAJEURE OR OTHERWISE SHALL BE LIMTED TO DIRECT ACTUAL DAMAGES. ECOPLUS POWER WILL NOT



BE LIABLE TO YOU OR ANY THIRD PARTY FOR CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, PUNITIVE, EXEMPLARY OR INDIRECT DAMAGES. ECOPLUS POWER IS NOT LIABLE FOR INTERRUPTIONS TO, OR SHORTAGES OF, ELECTRICITY SUPPLY, NOT ANY ASSOCIATED LOSS OR DAMAGE RESULTING THEREFROM. THESE LIMITATIONS APPLY WITHOUT REGARD TO THE CAUSE OF ANY LIABILITY OR DAMAGE. THERE ARE NO THRID-PARTY BENEFICIARIES TO THIS AGREEMENT.

16. Indemnification- EcoPlus Power's Representations and Warranties: Limitation: You are responsible for, and will immediately indemnify EcoPlus Power against, any and all loss or damage resulting from (a) your failure to fully comply with this Agreement; or (b) your use or misuse of electricity after it is delivered to you. THE ELECTRICITY PROVIDED UNDER THIS AGREEMENT WILL MEET THE QUALITY STANDARD OF THE APPLICABLE EDU AND WILL BE SUPPLIED FROM A VARIETY OF ELECTRIC GENERATION SOURCES INVOUDING THE ELECTRICITY PROVIDED PURSUANT TO ANY RENEWABLE ENERGY PLAN REQUIREMENT. ECOPLUS POWER MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES OTHER THAN THOSE EXPRESSLY SET FORTH IN THIS AGREEMENT. ECOPLUS POWER EXPRESIVLY DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS OF RA PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

- **18. Taxes:** Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement or required by law, all taxes of whatsoever kind, nature and description, due and payable with respect to your performance of your obligations under this Agreement, will be paid by you. Any tax levied against EcoPlus Power by any governmental entity that must be paid by EcoPlus Power, exclusive of EcoPlus Power's income tax or taxes levied on EcoPlus Power's real or personal property, shall be passed through to and paid by you. You must provide EcoPlus Power with any applicable exemption certificates.
- **19. Regulatory Changes.** This Agreement is subject to present and future legislation, orders, rules, regulations or decisions of a duly constituted governmental authority having jurisdiction over this Agreement or the services to be provided hereunder. If at some future date there is a change in any law, rule, regulation, tariff, or regulatory structure ("Regulatory Change") which impacts any term, condition or provision of this Agreement including, but not limited to price, EcoPlus Power shall have the right to modify this Agreement to reflect such Regulatory Change by providing 30 days' written notice of such modification to the Customer.
- **20. Miscellaneous:** This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Pennsylvania, without regard for the conflicts of law provisions thereof. The Agreement shall be considered the entire agreement between the Parties, superseding all verbal and written understandings. This Agreement shall only be amended in a writing signed by both parties or in accordance with the Renewal process identified herein. The individual undertaking the enrollment process on your behalf warrants that he or she is authorized to (a) enter into this Agreement on your behalf, (b) make decisions with respect to the Accounts,



and (c) enroll with and change the Accounts' electricity supplier to EcoPlus Power. You should contact the EDC in the event of an electric emergency. Future correspondence may be sent by EcoPlus Power to you via first class mail, postcard, SMS/text messaging, and/or electronic mail. This Agreement is binding upon you and EcoPlus Power, and will further bind each of your successors and permitted assigns.

VERIFICATION
