Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In response to the Answer and New Matter received from Margaret A. Morris, Esq. on September 21, 2021, I am submitting my acknowledgment of its receipt and my intention to continue to pursue this matter.

Regarding the **NEW MATTER** received:

11. The Transmission Line is not owned or maintained by Met-Ed.

The Transmission Line is owned by MAIT (Mid-Atlantic Interstate Transmission, LLC) as noted in Ms. Morris response. However, First Energy is the owner of MAIT. I did list in my PUC formal complaint that First Energy/Met Ed were the subject of my complaint, not specifically Metropolitan Edison Company as her response indicated.

12. The Complaint is filed against the wrong entity.

The transmission lines involved are owned solely by MAIT; however, First Energy Transmission, LLC is the parent company of MAIT. First Energy Corporation owns 10 electric companies, including Met-Ed. Since First Energy owns MAIT, First Energy should be involved as well as MAIT. Unless, First Energy allows MAIT to make these decisions regarding my concerns.

I look forward to additional communication regarding the matters of concern and do not plan on withdrawing my complaint.
