
In reference to the attached letter, we would like to respond to the "NEW MATTER" section, specifically items 11 and 12.

Being an electric consumer, we really had no prior information to indicate that the owner of the powerlines referenced in the attached document were not owned by Met Ed. Upon doing some research, we realized that although Met Ed, may have once owned them, the ownership was transferred to MAIT in January 2017. In fact, we are also attaching a letter from Michael M Espinoza who is the Senior Real Estate Representative from First Energy Service company on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company. Because of his stated representation, to me, it seem logical to believe that the owner of the powerlines was in fact Met Ed.

Because of this technicality, I would like to correct our initial filing to reflect the fact that our complaint now should be filed with the understanding that MAIT is the current owner. It is our hope that this sufficiently addresses the concerns identified as items 11 and 12 and ask to amend our initial complaint accordingly.

**Notice of Transmission Line Construction**  
*Energizing the Future*  
**Campbelltown-Middletown-North Hershey**

Dear Property Owner:

Metropolitan Edison, a FirstEnergy company, is planning upgrades to the transmission line adjacent to your property to enhance electric service reliability. The project involves replacing the aging structures and wires you see today with new ones constructed within the existing right-of-way.

Field survey activities are now complete, and construction is set to begin around mid-September 2021. This work will continue for several months within the existing easement that crosses a portion of your property. During this time, construction contractors will periodically access the right-of-way and transmission line structures adjacent to your property. Areas disturbed during construction will be restored as soon as practical after construction is completed. We do not anticipate any disruption to your electric service because of this project.

On behalf of FirstEnergy, Burns & McDonnell will provide program management services on the project. Appalachian Field Service, LLC, (AFS) will provide landowner support and J.W. Didado, an experienced transmission line contractor, will handle construction. You may have already been contacted by an AFS agent regarding impacts to your property. They will continue to be available concerning construction activities.


