Enclosed for filing on behalf of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric") is a Damage Release between PPL Electric and the Borough of Slatington located in Lehigh County, Pennsylvania. This agreement is being filed pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S.A. § 507.

As part of the C14 East Palmerton Transmission Line Rebuild Project, a private road owned by the Borough of Slatington was used for access and sustained minimal damage. Following discussions with the Borough, compensation in the amount of \$750.00 was determined based on the approximation of the cost to have the necessary amount of stone delivered to the site.

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.11, the enclosed document is to be deemed filed on October 14, 2021, which is the date it was filed electronically using the Commission's E-filing system.

### Damage Release

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Borough of Slatington, of 125 South Walnut Street, Slatington, Pennsylvania 18080, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$750.00) in hand paid by **PPL Electric Utilities Corporation**, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, quitclaim and forever discharge the said PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, its respective officers, agents, employees, successors, assigns and all persons or entities, whether or not named herein, who may be jointly or severally liable, of and from all suits, claims, demands, actions, damages and claims for damages or contribution whatsoever arising out of or resulting from any injury, loss or damage that may have been caused to **a private access road from the C14 East Palmerton Transmission Line Rebuild**, crops, grain, land, and personal property in the Township of Washington, County of Lehigh, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by reason of the construction, reconstruction and/or maintenance by the said PPL Electric Utilities Corporation of its overhead and/or underground electric line facilities, upon, over, under and across said property to the day of the date of these presents. Owner shall maintain in the strictest confidence the terms of this Agreement, including the amount payable hereunder.

**This Agreement is between a public utility and a municipal corporation and is therefore subject to Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") review pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S.A. § 507. The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be the later of i) thirty (30) days from the date that PPL submits the Agreement to the PUC; or ii) if the PUC opens an investigation of the Agreement, on the date the PUC approves the Agreement.**
