We represent Agway Energy Services LLC ("Agway"), a licensed electrical generation supplier ("EGS") in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Agway applied for an EGS license in 2011 and the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") opened Docket No. A-2011-2277881 for that purpose. The Commission granted Agway a EGS license in April 2012 and designated Agway's EGS license number as A-2011-2277881.

It has recently been brought to our attention that the Commission does not have a record of Agway's 2020 Request to Maintain Reduction in Financial Security Amount of 5% Gross Receipts. As such, Agway is hereby withdrawing the request to "maintain reduction" and will be submitting a petition for reduction.
