SUPPLY CUSTOMERS TO DEFAULT SERVICE**

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

The purpose of this letter is to provide notice to the Commission, the Statutory Parties and affected Electric Distribution Companies of the impending transfer of the residential customers of Capital Energy PA LLC d/b/a Sunrise Power & Gas ("Capital") to default service. Capital serves residential customers in the service territories of PPL, PECO and Duquesne Light Co. Due to the ongoing pandemic and other factors out of its control, Capital's present intentions are to continue to serve non-residential customers, but to cease serving residential customers for the foreseeable future. Stated differently, Capital does not intend to seek abandonment of its license or its ability to continue to serve customers in any service territory but does intend to cease serving residential customers for the immediate future.

All affected customers will be notified via first class mail of the impending switch at least 30 days before the switching is expected to commence, noting that Duquesne customers will receive 90 days' notice. A copy of the notice is attached as Exhibit A. It is expected that PPL customers (approx. 2847) and PECO customers (approx. 1019) will be switched commencing 12/01/21 and concluding on 12/07/21. Pursuant to an agreement with Duquesne, those customers (approx. 1168) will be switched beginning 02/01/22 and be complete by approximately 02/04/22.

Capital is current with all assessments owed to the Commission and is current with all reporting requirements and will continue to ensure that it remains current. If there are any questions or concerns regarding this notice, please contact the undersigned.
