**RE: Robert G. Collins v. The York Water Company**  
**Docket Nos. C-2021-3028154 and C-2021-3028155**

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

The York Water Company (“York Water” or the “Company”) hereby files this letter regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

On October 28, 2021, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued the Initial Decision (“ID”) of Administrative Law Judge Steven K. Haas (“ALJ”), which granted York Water’s Preliminary Objections and dismissed the Formal Complaint of Robert G. Collins (“Complainant”). The ID found that the Complaint challenging York Water’s acquisition of the water and wastewater systems serving Albright Mobile Home Park (“Albright MHP”) was premature because York Water had not yet filed Applications with the Commission regarding such acquisitions.

This letter seeks to inform you that York Water recently filed Applications with the Commission to acquire the water and wastewater systems serving Albright MHP. Specifically, on October 20, 2021, York Water filed a Joint Application with SYC WWTP, L.P. (Docket Nos. A-2021-3029231 and A-2021-3029237) requesting, among other things, Commission approval for the Company to acquire Albright MHP’s wastewater collection system. On October 25, 2021, York Water filed an Application (Docket No. A-2021-3029261) seeking Commission approval for the Company to acquire Albright MHP’s water distribution assets.

When the ID was issued, York Water was in the process of preparing an amended Answer and New Matter and an amended Preliminary Objection, which would have reflected the Commission filings referenced above.

Notices of these Applications will be published pursuant to the Commission's directives in the applicable secretarial letters issued at those dockets. As set forth in those Notices, any protests or petitions to intervene regarding those Applications are due by November 22, 2021.

If the Complainant so chooses, he can file a protest to either of those Applications by the established deadline. *See* ID, p. 7 (stating that "if/when York Water files an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience with the Commission seeking approval of its purchase of the AMHP's water and sewer facilities and its provision of service to AMHP's customers, Mr. Collins will have an opportunity to object to the transaction").

Copies of this letter will be provided as indicated on the Certificate of Service.
