Rear Entrance Restoration

- Prepare the lane for paving by cleaning, edging and running string lines as needed.
- Mill all adjacent blacktop surfaces as needed for a level transition.
- Tack coat the asphalt to be paved.
- Place a scratch of asphalt over low or depressed areas as needed.
- Place 9.5mm wearing surface to a **compacted depth** of **1 1/2 inches**.
- Place a **non-tracking** tar on the adjoining blacktop edges as needed.

Cart Expansion Areas

- Saw cut blacktop surfaces to create an edge for the new blacktop to abut.
- Excavate 9" and remove the existing blacktop and sub-soil surface.
- Place, grade and compact 6" of 2a modified stone and compact.
- Place 9.5mm wearing surface to a **compacted depth** of **3 inches**.
- Place a **non-tracking** tar on the adjoining blacktop edges as needed.

Area 2 (10 SY) Total Cost \$ 1,990.00

Guarantee: All material and workmanship is guaranteed for a period of (1) one year.
