

Applicant, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, files this Application pursuant to the provisions of 66 Pa.C.S § 2702 and 52 Pa. Code § 5.13 for the alteration of the public at grade crossing where Township Road 942, Lower Coleville Road, crosses tracks of SEDACOG Joint Rail Authority at DOT Number 843 020 P in Spring Township, Centre County as described below:

1. The name and address of Applicant are Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, Dean D. Ball, P.E., Assistant District Executive, Engineering District 2-0, 70 PennDOT Drive, Clearfield, PA 16830.

5. The Applicant is seeking approval to rehabilitate the existing bridge structure. Rehabilitation may encroach on the railroad crossing. The railroad crossing is adjacent and within 50 feet of the existing bridge structure. A Location Map is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit “B”.

6. The Applicant is not aware of prior Public Utility Commission proceedings for this crossing.

7. The average daily traffic for Lower Coleville Road at this crossing is 667 vehicles with 5% trucks.

8. The estimated total cost for the project subject to the application and described above is \$650,000.00. The Applicant anticipates that the funding for the project will be 0% federal funds.

9. This project is necessary and proper for the safety and convenience of the public.

10. A conference of all parties of interest should be held to discuss the proposed project

Wherefore, Applicant respectfully requests that the Public Utility Commission approve this Application.

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

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SPRING TOWNSHIP, CENTRE COUNTY, AUTHORIZING PENNDOT TO REQUEST RAILROAD CROSSING UPGRADES AT TOWNSHIP ROAD 942 (LOWER COLEVILLE ROAD), BELLEFONTE, PA 16823 FROM THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, Township Road 942 (Lower Coleville Road) is a public roadway under the jurisdiction of the Township of Spring; and

WHEREAS, a railroad operated through Spring Township, which Railroad maintains a crossing over Township Road 942 (Lower Coleville Road); and

WHEREAS, in order for the proposed improvements to the Township Road 942 (Lower Coleville Road) bridge structure to be made pertaining to the railroad crossing, such improvements must be submitted to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") by and through the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation ("PennDOT");

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Spring Township as follows:


1. PennDOT is authorized on behalf and for Spring Township to request approval of the PUC for the proposed improvements to the Township Road 942 (Lower Coleville Road) bridge structure near the railroad crossing at Township Road 942 (Lower Coleville Road) in Spring Township.
2. PennDOT is authorized on behalf and for Spring Township to issue Notice to Proceed letters to the Railroad for design and/or construction at the railroad crossing at Township Road 942 (Lower Coleville Road) in Spring Township.

RESOLVED, this 4th day of October 2021, in public meeting duly noticed and assembled.




