STATUS REPORT OF STARLINK SERVICES, LLC

AND NOW COMES Starlink Services, LLC (“Starlink”), by and through its counsel, Cozen O’Connor, to file this Status Report pursuant to the Order of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) entered in this matter on October 28, 2021 (“October 2021 Order”).

1. Ordering Paragraph 3 of the October 28, 2021 Order requires Starlink to file a quarterly status report with the Commission, beginning on November 24, 2021. This report is to indicate whether Starlink’s network is capable of self-provisioning access to the Public Switched Telecommunications Network (“PSTN”) or whether Starlink is securing a third-party managed service provider that will facilitate Starlink’s voice service accessing the PSTN. In the alternative, the status report is to indicate whether Starlink has been authorized by the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) to receive awarded Rural Digital Opportunity Fund (“RDOF”) high-cost support in any jurisdiction where it submitted a winning bid.

2. As of this date, Starlink has not yet been authorized by the FCC to receive awarded RDOF high-cost support in any jurisdiction where it submitted a winning bid.

3. As of this date, Starlink’s parent company, Space Exploration Technologies Corp. (“SpaceX”), is negotiating with third-party managed service providers (“MSPs”) that will facilitate Starlink’s voice service accessing the PSTN. SpaceX has had several detailed conversations with

two MSPs in October and November, and contractual negotiations are actively progressing. Although an agreement has not yet been executed, the parties are making a good faith effort to reach an agreement in the near future. Starlink will notify the Commission if an agreement is reached before the next quarterly status report is due.
