<b>2. Medium Non-Residential</b>	Annual peak load 100 kW - 500 KW. Annual peak load is defined as the highest one hour usage in a twelve month period.
<b>3. Large Non-Residential</b>	Annual peak load > 500 kW. Annual peak load is defined as the highest one hour usage in a twelve month period.

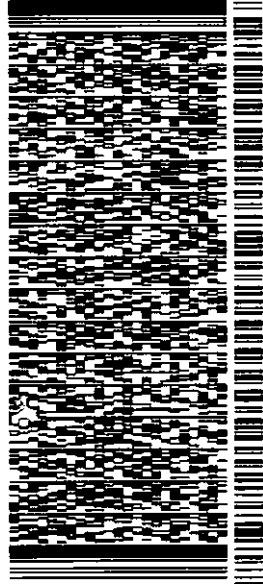
