#### PREHEARING MEMORANDUM OF THE CITY OF YORK

Pursuant to the November 22, 2021, Prehearing Conference Order issued by Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Steven K. Haas, the City of York ("City") hereby submits this Prehearing Memorandum in the above-captioned proceeding.

## I. HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On July 1, 2021, Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") submitted the above-captioned Application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §§507,1102(a), and 1329. *See* 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 507,1102(a), and 1329.

On August 12, 2021, the Commission issued a letter indicating conditional acceptance of

PAWC's Application.

On October 29, 2021, the Commission issued a letter informing counsel for PAWC that it

has accepted PAWC's Application.

On November 8, 2021, the City filed a Petition to Intervene in this proceeding. A

description of the City is set forth in Paragraph 2 of its Petition to Intervene. The City's Petition to

Intervene is pending and awaits disposition by the ALJ.

the Asset Purchase Agreement, the City anticipates supporting PAWC's Application to acquire the

wastewater system assets pursuant to Section 1329 of the Public Utility Code. The City reserves

its right to address other matters during this proceeding that may be raised by other parties.
