Please accept this Letter regarding the status of the Joint Petition for Settlement referenced in the *Interim Order*, dated December 14, 2021.

Subsequent to the hearing on November 14, 2021, the parties reached an agreement in principle. Documents reflecting the Settlement as well as the Joint Petition for Settlement were sent to Ms. Herr for execution on Friday, December 17, 2021, *via* UPS, for delivery on Monday, December 20, 2021.

I contacted Ms. Herr on Wednesday, December 23, 2021, to inquire as to the status of the executed documents. Ms. Herr advised *via* text that she had COVID and provided her results from a lab.
