On December 10, 2021, a transaction involving EMEX’s indirect corporate parent, Mantis Innovation Group, LLC (“MIG”), resulted in all of MIG’s assets, including EMEX, to be transferred to an unrelated entity, Mantis Holdings Group, LLC.
