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AND NOW comes the Complainant, by and through their attorneys, John P. Corcoran, Jr., Esquire, Mark E. Casper, Jr., and Jones, Gregg, Creehan & Gerace, LLP, and files this within Status Report pursuant to presiding Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge's December 29, 2021 Second Interim Order on Remand, and states as follows:

1. Following a discussion between counsel in this case, as well as counsel for Respondent in the Court of Common Pleas action¹, counsel for Complainant discontinued the Court of Common Pleas action without prejudice on November 3, 2021.

2. The conversation between counsel centered primarily around permitting Complainant to have an electrical engineer conduct a field visit to test the at-issue transformer.

3. Following that conversation, counsel for Complainant has earnestly searched for an electrical engineer to conduct on-site testing of the at-issue transformer.

4. However, the majority of local electrical engineers contacted by counsel for Complainant have expressed an unwillingness to provide the requested services due in

large part to Respondent being a major electrical utility in the greater Pittsburgh area; the local electrical engineers have expressed a concern that their participation in an adversarial process with Respondent may affect future business contacts.

5. Accordingly, counsel for Complainant is currently working to obtain the services of a non-local electrical engineer.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Complainant respectfully requests a hearing be scheduled in the above-captioned matter in sixty (60) days, such as to permit Complainant to obtain an electrical engineer and conduct an on-site test of the at-issue transformer.
