CPOWER PETITION TO INTERVENE


Pursuant to the Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") scheduling order in the above-captioned dockets, and the Rule 5.71, et seq. of the Commission's Regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.71, et seq., Enerwise Global Technologies, d/b/a CPower Energy Management ("CPower") moves to intervene in this proceeding. In support of this Petition, CPower states:

1. On December 17, 2021, the Commission issued a NOTICE OF PROCEEDING AND OPPORTUNITY TO INTERVENE in the above-captioned matter and established a deadline for filing a petition to intervene of January 18, 2022.
2. CPower is a leading provider of distributed energy resource load management services in Pennsylvania and throughout the United States.
3. CPower is a Curtailment Service Provider in the PJM wholesale market and relies upon access to customer-authorized account and energy usage data from First Energy utilities and other Pennsylvania utilities to fulfill requirements of PJM market participation.

4. CPower supports the First Energy utilities' efforts to establish a Third-Party Data Access Tariff in order to promote efficient and secure access to customer data.
5. CPower has an interest which may be directly affected and which is not adequately represented by any other party, and is likely to be bound by the action of the Commission in this proceeding.
6. Granting this petition permitting CPower participation in this proceeding is in the public interest.

Wherefore, CPower respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene and for such other and further relief as this cause may require.
