**Letter Petition for Leave to Withdraw Complaint**

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) files this letter petition for leave to withdraw the Complaint in the above-captioned case pursuant to 52 Pa Code § 5.94.

On June 28, 2019, I&E filed a Complaint alleging that Erie Transportation Services Inc. t/a Erie Yellow Cab (“Erie” or “Respondent”) failed to report its gross intrastate operating revenues for the 2016 calendar year and satisfy its 2015-2016, 2016-2017, and 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Assessments totaling \$54,704 in violation of 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 510(b)-(c), respectively. I&E’s Complaint requested that Erie pay its outstanding assessments and a civil penalty of \$14,700 or be subject to cancellation of its Certificate of Public Convenience (“Certificate”).

On August 6, 2019, Erie filed an Application for Abandonment (“Application”) of its Certificate at Docket No. A-00108419. On August 15, 2019, the Commission cancelled Respondent’s property authority at Docket No. A-2019-3012047. On September 16, 2019, I&E filed a Protest to Erie’s Application to ensure that the Application was approved only if Respondent satisfied its outstanding assessment balance and civil penalty as requested in I&E’s Complaint at Docket No. C-2019-3011255. That same day, the Commission cancelled Erie’s taxi authority at Docket No. A-2019-3012048 despite both I&E’s pending Complaint and Protest.

Given that the Commission granted Respondent’s Application and cancelled its Certificate, I&E is withdrawing the Complaint in the above-captioned matter. If no party objects within ten (10) days of service of this letter, this case should be marked closed.


