Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I'm writing you this letter in response to answer matter at hand concerning my electric bill, I first want to start off by stating that I have no intent on turning this into some long drawn out legal matter, I only wanted to make arrangements on my electric bill without the service being interrupted. I understand that my property is zoned commercial, and that there are tenants in rear of my property, However Due to all which has happened during this Coronus virus my tenant were not able to pay rent which includes there electric, with that being the case we did not qualify for any assistance programs and without being able to evict or vacate the tenants we have just gotten overwhelmed by the past due amount.

I have tried to make arrangements on this bill and will continue to pay down on the at a rate or amount of 1500 per month hopefully the electric company can give use the time needed to get the past due amount paid off and continue with service without any interruptions.

As I explained to the representative at the electric company that the solution to this problem is simple we would like to place individual meters on the units and have tenants be responsible for their own electrical usage however I was told that in order for this to happen we would have to pay the balance on the electrical bill off, this present a problem because the tenants use electric and the bill goes right back up to an astronomical amount which makes it difficult to payoff.

This is why I was reaching out to you for help in mediating an agreement between the two parties that would allow us to keep our service without the threat of interruptions this is a stressful for me because I do have tenants in rear of property and don't want to take rents if I not sure they can keep the lights and heaters on.

I'm only asking the commission for help not a long draw out law suite, my feeling on that is why would we spend thousands of dollars on attorneys when those monies could go towards the bill and help resolve the problem not make it worse than it already is. Please help me to find a solution that works for both parties I'm a small business just establish in 2019 and we are only asking for guidance and help from someone somewhere so tenants and myself don't have to be in cold this winter.



If this is not the correct way to responded and we have no choice but to obtain an attorney, please do let me know again we are not wealthy people just hard working and it is my purpose and plan to pay the balance of this bill off and get meters in the units, again I appreciate all your help.

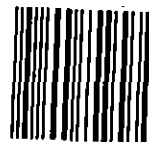
