Re: Cancellation of Tenaska Resources LLC's ACT 17 registration of the Tioga County, PA pipeline.

Madame Secretary,

I am writing in regard to the 2.3 miles of pipeline located in Tioga County, Pennsylvania that Tenaska Resources LLC had previously registered under Act 127. VEC Energy LLC acquired this pipeline from Tenaska Resources LLC, but it is our position that the Act 127 mandate does not apply to this pipeline and that Tenaska should not have filed this pipeline with Act 127. Therefore, we respectfully request a termination of this registration.

The 2.3 miles of pipeline is a production line only as defined by API 80, CFR Section 49 CFR 192.8 (a), Section 2.4.4 production a) piping. This pipeline extends from the Austinburg # 1H well directly to the transmission line. The Q&A from the Commission's Act 127 web page (see pg. 2, 1<sup>st</sup> Q&A) states that Production lines are not required to be registered. In addition, there are not any farm taps on this well or pipeline.

Please be advised that VEC Energy LLC did not acquire the 1.3 miles of pipeline that Tenaska Resources LLC has registered in Potter County, PA. VEC Energy LLC acquired only the Tioga County pipeline, prior to Tenaska Resources LLC going out of business.

Based on the above information, per our interpretation the 2.3 miles of pipeline located in Tioga County, Pennsylvania that VEC Energy LLC acquired from Tenaska Resources LLC is not subject to Act 127 registration.

Please advise if anything further is required from VEC Energy LLC for this matter.
