

Please find attached Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 (this tariff cancels Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 1) for Hopkins & Sons, Inc. (PA PUC Certificate #A-8916633), 1 Bellecor Drive, New Castle DE 19720. Changes are an **INCREASE** in handling charges for pianos, organs, grandfather/grandmother clocks & gun cabinets, a **CHANGE** in verbiage making rates applicable for moves between points in Pennsylvania, an **INCREASE** in charges for containers, and an **INCREASE** in hourly rates. SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 20 - ADVANCE RESERVATIONS

Advance reservations must be made prior to the service being rendered.

ITEM 30 - DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATION POLICY

All reservations require a \$200.00 deposit per truck per day. This deposit is refundable up to 72 business hours prior to the service date. Within the 72 hours cancellation period and the service date, the deposit is non-refundable. All deposits must be received within 48 hours of the time the reservation was made.

ITEM 40 - ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

All tolls, parking fees, and other out-of-pocket expenses will be the responsibility of the customer and added to the carrier's charges.

ITEM 50 - HOURLY RATES

Hourly rates begin from the time the vehicle and personnel leave the carrier's place of business and ends at the time the vehicles and personnel return to the carrier's place of business. All charges are calculated in one-half (1/2) hour increments and rounded up to the next one-half (1/2) hour.

ITEM 60 - PIANOS, ORGANS, GRANDFATHER/GRANDMOTHER CLOCKS AND GUN CABINETS

When a piano, organ, grandfather/grandmother clock and gun cabinets weighing up to 800 pounds are a part of the shipment, carrier will assess the following charges in addition to the applicable hourly rates published herein:

◆ Pianos and Organs	50.00
◆ Grandfather/Grandmother Clocks	75.00
◆ Gun Cabinets	100.00

SECTION 2

ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

▲ **ITEM 200**

In lieu of the applicable rates provided for in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. Nos. 50 and 51, the following rates will apply for shipments transported between points in Pennsylvania and traveling distances of forty (40) miles and less and distances in excess of of forty (40) miles. All charges shown are in dollars and cents.

NOTE A - Cubical content must be shown on all cartons.

NOTE B - In the event that two or more standard containers must be joined together because of the size, shape or character of the item or items to be packed, the charge for the container shall be the combined charge for all cartons use.

NOTE C - In lieu of the applicable packing and unpacking charges in Tariffs 50-T and 51-W, apply hourly rates shown on Page 4 herein.

SECTION 2
SCHEDULE OF RATES

ITEM 300

▲ Applicable on the transportation of household goods in use transported distances of forty (40) miles and less between points in Pennsylvania.

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 below, the transportation charge on any shipment shall be a combination of the applicable traveling charge in Column 1 plus the hourly charge at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply from time of departure from carrier's facility located at 1 Bellecor Drive, New Castle DE 19720 and continue until the estimated travel time back to carrier's facility at 1 Bellecopr Drive, New Castle DE 19720.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half (1/2) hour considered as one-half (1/2) hour.

NOTE 4 - When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 2 shall apply.

NOTE 5 - Minimum total transportation charges:

- (a) Column 2 will apply a four (4) hours minimum.
- (b) Column 3 will apply a two (2) hours minimum.
- (c) Column 4 will apply a three (3) hours minimum.

NOTE 6 - All hourly charges start at the time of departure for vehicles and personnel from carrier's facility located at 1 Bellecor Drive, New Castle DE 19720. The charges will continue until the estimated travel time back to carrier's facility at 1 Bellecor Drive, New Castle DE 19720.
