MOTION FOR MODIFICATON OF BRIEFING SCHEDULE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a modification to the briefing schedule outlined in the ALJ's January 5, 2021 Order.

1. A telephonic hearing for this matter was held on November 12, 2021 at 10:00 AM. At the conclusion of the hearing, the ALJ indicated that once the transcript of the proceedings was received, a Briefing Order would be issued.
2. On January 5, 2022, Judge Heep issued her Briefing Order which established that main briefs would be due on February 7, 2022 and reply brief due on February 28, 2022.
3. Despite several unsuccessful attempts to identify and ultimately contact the correct court reporting agency, PECO did not receive a copy of the November 12, 2022 hearing transcript until late in the day on January 25, 2022.
4. The undersigned will be drafting the main brief on behalf of PECO Energy. The undersigned will be out of state on a pre-planned trip between February 1, 2022 and February 10, 2022. Therefore, a modification to the Briefing Order is being requested.
5. The undersigned Counsel for PECO has contacted Counsel for Ms. Eubanks, Joline Price, Esquire, and Ms. Price has no objection to an extension of the briefing schedule.

6. PECO avers that this request is greater than three (3) days prior to the main briefing deadline set forth in the January 5, 2022 and is consistent with 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).
