

Dear Ms. Roth,

Please find attached Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 (this tariff cancels Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 6) for Moody Movers, Inc. (PA PUC Certificate #A-00111023), 4238 Cold Spring Creamery Road, Doylestown PA 18902. Changes are a **CHANGE** in verbiage for transporting household goods between points in Pennsylvania as Moody Movers, Inc. was granted statewide authority in May 2015, an **INCREASE** in handling charges for pianos and miscellaneous bulky items weighing in excess of 250 pounds, an **INCREASE** in charges for rigging, hoisting or lowering articles, an **INCREASE** in flight carry charge for pianos & heavy articles, a **CHANGE** in the application & charge for deposits, an **INCREASE** in charges for containers, an **INCREASE** in Non-Peak Season hourly rates, the **ADDITION** of Peak Season hourly rates, and a **CHANGE** in the application of waiting charges. All other items and rates in the tariff remain the same. This tariff is filed by Charlie Morris Consulting LLC on behalf of Scott Moody, President, Moody Movers, Inc. The Issue Date for Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 is February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, with an Effective Date of March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022. SECTION 1  
RULES & REGULATIONS

**ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**ITEM 20 - DECLARED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

**ITEM 30 - PACKING AND UNPACKING (#)**

Packing and unpacking will be performed on an hourly basis plus the cost of containers (Item 100) and such labor will be charged at labor rates shown in Section 3, Item 300, herein.

**ITEM 40 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY**

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

**ITEM 50 - PIANO CARRY CHARGES & OTHER HEAVY ITEMS (#)**

When a piano or other heavy article (weighing in excess of 250 pounds) are part of a shipment, carrier will assess the following charges in addition to the applicable hourly rates published herein:

**PIANOS**                      Spinet - \$125.00                      Upright - \$175.00                      Baby Grand - \$250.00

◆ **MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS WEIGHING IN EXCESS OF 250 POUNDS** (including Safes & Fireproof File Cabinets) - \$125.00

◆ **MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS WEIGHING IN EXCESS OF 500 POUNDS** (including Safes & Fireproof File Cabinets) - \$250.00

SECTION 1

RULES & REGULATIONS

**ITEM 60 - RIGGING, HOISTING, OR LOWERING (#)**

When it is necessary to use rigging, hoisting, or lowering services in order to accomplish pick-up or delivery of a shipment, carrier will perform such services at the following rates:

◆ A flat charge of \$150.00 for first two articles and \$100.00 for each additional article after first two articles.

**ITEM 70 - FLIGHT CARRY CHARGE - PIANOS AND HEAVY ARTICLES (#)**

When flight carry service of pianos and heavy articles (weighing in excess of 400 pounds) is provided by carrier, the following charges shall apply:

( a ) Inside a building, the first flight shall consist of a total of at least eight (8) steps. Additional flights shall be defined as the number of complete floors above or below the first flight.

( b ) Outside a building, the number of flights shall be determined based on the total number of steps as follows: 8 to 17 steps inclusive - 1 flight; 18 to 37 steps inclusive - 2 flights; 38 to 57 steps inclusive - 3 flights; and 58 to 77 steps inclusive - 4 flights

◆ ( c ) A charge of \$150.00 per flight per article

**ITEM 80 - DEPOSIT - CONFIRMATION OF JOB**

▲ Carrier will require a deposit equal to 25% of the estimated cost per truck and crew per day to confirm booking of the job. When moving service is completed, the amount of the deposit will be shown on carrier's Bill of Lading to determine correct amount due from shipper. A receipt will be given by the carrier to the shipper indicating the amount and time of the deposit.

**ITEM 85 - FULL VALUE PROTECTION**

Provisions of Rule 38, Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 50 will apply except minimum declared value will be based on \$20,000.00.

SECTION 3  
HOURLY RATES

**ITEM 300**

Applicable on the transportation of CLASS 1 SHIPMENTS (Item 40) transported distances of 40 miles and less between points within Pennsylvania.

Subject to Notes 1 to 4 below, the transportation charges on any shipment will be assessed from the time vehicle & crew depart carrier's terminal to first point of origin and continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final delivery (including any additional pickups or deliveries), completion of unloading at final delivery, and returning to carrier's terminal - Rates are Portal to Portal.

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2 and 3) are computed in quarter-hour periods; fractions of a quarter-hour are considered as one quarter-hour.

NOTE 3 - MINIMUM CHARGE: Column 2 hourly rates subject to a five (5) hours minimum charge. Column 3 rates subject to a four (4) hours minimum charge.

NOTE 4 - In lieu of the applicable pickup or delivery transportation rates on storage-in-transit shipments transported distances of forty (40) miles and less as provided in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 50-T and 51-W issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent for carrier, the following charges shall apply:

( a ) Apply hourly rates in this item. Minimum transportation charge is five (5) hours at rates named herein. Hourly rates apply on loading, actual movement or transportation and unloading, except as provided in ( b ) below.

( b ) Where a storage-in-transit shipment is not unloaded at carrier's warehouse, and shipment remains on carrier's vehicle, and overnight S.I.T. flat charge of \$150.00 per vehicle will be assessed.

▲ ( c ) Waiting charges will be assessed by carrier on the basis of the equipment and labor used to bring shipment into S.I.T. at the applicable hourly rates shown herein from 9:00AM following overnight S.I.T. flat charge until carrier's equipment and labor arrive at customer's location for unloading. Thereafter, carrier's hourly rates herein will be assessed based on the equipment and labor furnished by the carrier from the commencement of unloading until completion of unloading, dismissal of equipment and labor by the shipper at destination, and return to the carrier's terminal.
