Below please find the response of PECO Energy Company (“PECO”) to the Secretarial Letter dated January 18, 2022, regarding the current status of the subject transmission project and submission of final project costs to the Commission.

The outage for the 220-22 project was postponed from Fall 2021 to Spring 2022 at SEPTA’s request. Installation of foundations was completed in January 2022, and the outage to support the erection of the new steel poles is now scheduled from 5/14/2022 to 5/30/2022. Costs to date are \$3,900,236.64. PECO’s updated project cost estimate is \$6.4 million, which includes allocated overhead and indirect costs. As noted in the LON, PennDOT will be reimbursing PECO for the cost of the project. PECO will submit final project costs to the Commission upon completion of the project.


