
On January 28, 2022, Duquesne Light Company (Duquesne Light) filed an Installation, Operation, and Maintenance Agreement (Agreement) with the Port Authority of Allegheny County (Port Authority) to install electrical infrastructure to deliver service to, and provide rebates for, certain DC fast charging units at the Port Authority's East Liberty Bus Garage. Duquesne Light will provide a rebate to the Port Authority for the Port Authority's actual costs in an amount not to exceed \$680,000. The Agreement is consistent with Duquesne Light's Joint Petition for Settlement at Docket No. R-2021-3024750 which was approved by the Commission on December 16, 2021. The Agreement was filed pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 507. On February 10, 2022, the Commission initiated a proceeding to review the Agreement pursuant to §507.

Upon review, the Agreement appears to be reasonable and consistent with the public interest and the Agreement is hereby approved. However, approval of the agreement does not preclude the Commission from investigating, during any formal proceeding, the reasonableness of this Installation, Operation, and Maintenance Agreement.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within (20) days of the date of this letter.
