**PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS OF
MID-ATLANTIC INTERSTATE TRANSMISSION, LLC
TO THE AMENDED COMPLAINT OF REBECCA WALIZER**

Mid-Atlantic Interstate Transmission, LLC (Respondent or MAIT), by and through its attorneys, Reger Rizzo & Darnall LLP, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.101, hereby submits its Preliminary Objections to the Amended Complaint filed by Rebecca Walizer (Complainant).

MAIT avers the Complainant lacks standing to bring this legal proceeding in either her individual or representative capacity. The Amended Complaint is therefore barred pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.101(a)(7). MAIT requests that the Commission grant its Preliminary Objections and dismiss the Amended Complaint without a hearing.

In support of its preliminary objections, MAIT states as follows:

I. Procedural Background

1. The Complainant filed an Amended Complaint objecting to MAIT’s decision to rebuild the 72 (Campbelltown-Middletown-North Hershey) 69 kV Transmission Line

(Transmission Line) with “like” facilities (i.e. overhead with wooden poles) (the Project) in her residential Development. A copy of the Amended Complaint is provided as Attachment 1.

2. The Transmission Line was constructed approximately 30 years before the Development was built and does *not* cross the Complainant’s property. She is not directly impacted by the Transmission Line.

3. Pursuant to 52. Pa. Code § 5.101, MAIT objects to the Amended Complaint on the grounds that the Complainant lacks standing to file or to prosecute a complaint.

II. Argument

4. The Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure permit parties to file preliminary objections. The grounds for preliminary objections are limited to those set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.101(a) as follows:

- (1) Lack of Commission jurisdiction or improper service of the pleading initiating the proceeding.
- (2) Failure of a pleading to conform to this chapter or the inclusion of scandalous or impertinent matter.
- (3) Insufficient specificity of a pleading.
- (4) Legal insufficiency of a pleading.
- (5) Lack of capacity to sue, nonjoinder of a necessary party or misjoinder of a cause of action.
- (6) Pendency of a prior proceeding or agreement for alternative dispute resolution.
- (7) Standing of a party to participate in the proceeding.

5. Commission’s procedure regarding the disposition of preliminary objections is similar to that utilized in Pennsylvania civil practice. *Equitable Small Transportation Intervenors v. Equitable Gas Company*, Docket No. C-00935435 (Opinion and Order entered July 18, 1994).

6. The Commission has held that a person or entity has standing when the person or entity has a direct, immediate and substantial interest in the subject matter of a proceeding. *Joint Application of Pennsylvania-American Water Co. and Evansburg Water Co. for Approval of the transfer, by sale, of the water works property and rights of Evansburg Water Co. to Pennsylvania-American Water Co.*, A-212285F0046/47 and A-210870F01 (Ordered entered July 9, 1998); *William Penn Parking Garage, Inc. v. City of Pittsburgh*, 464 Pa. 168, 346 A.2d 269 (1975); *Landlord Service Bureau, Inc. v. Equitable Gas Co.*, 79 Pa. P.U.C. 342 (1993); *Re Equitable Gas Co.*, 76 Pa. P.U.C. 23 (1992); *Manufacturers' Association of Erie v. City of Erie - Bureau of Water*, 50 Pa. P.U.C. 43 (1976); *Waddington v. Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission*, 670 A.2d 199 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1995), alloc. denied, 678 A.2d 368 (Pa. 1996).

7. Requiring a person or entity to have a direct, immediate, and substantial interest in the subject matter of a proceeding helps avoid frivolous, harassing lawsuits whose costs are ultimately borne, at least in part, by utility ratepayers. *Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission v. National Fuel Gas Distribution Corp.*, 73 Pa. P.U.C. 552 (1990).

8. Mere conjecture about possible future harm does not confer a direct interest in the subject matter of a proceeding. *Official Court Reporters of the Court of Common Pleas of Philadelphia County v. Pennsylvania Labor Relations Board*, 467 A.2d 311 (Pa. 1983).

9. The Transmission Line does **not** cross the Complainant's property. She has no direct, immediate or substantive interest in the Project.

WHEREFORE, Respondent, Mid-Atlantic Interstate Transmission, LLC, requests that the Amended Complaint filed by Rebecca Walizer be dismissed with prejudice or denied in its entirety for lack of standing to file or to prosecute a Formal Complaint.



12. First Energy Transmission, LLC is the parent company of MAIT. FE owns 10 electric companies, including Met-Ed. Since First Energy owns MAIT, First Energy should be involved, as well as MAIT.

12/23/2021 I received a Motion of Met-Ed for Judgement on the Pleadings for the case to be dismissed.

01/10/2022 Telephonic Prehearing Conference held

01/17/2022 My Answer to Motion was filed

My answer included: Reiteration that I originally requested First Energy to be a part of this complaint. I brought forth the information that correspondence to our neighborhood was on letterhead from FE and also included information that Met Ed was involved. I agreed that MAIT should be included as a respondent in this case.

01/18/2022 Cover letter submitted, accepted and filed with the PA PUC requesting to add MAIT.

I included a new first page of the formal complaint requesting my initial request to have FE listed as a respondent be honored.

02/05/2022 I have not had verification yet that FE will be added as a respondent, thus, I am sending in another request to amend the complaint and add them as per my original complaint. Perhaps, my original complaint was not clear.

First Energy Corp (FE) owns Metropolitan Edison Company. THEIR names have been on the correspondence to this neighborhood. MAIT is a subsidiary of First Energy Transmission (FET), which is also owned by FE.

Please accept my request to add MAIT and FE as respondents in my case.


