To Whom it May Concern:

On September 15, 2021, the Commission entered a Tentative Order, Docket No. M-2021-3028299, which advised Concorde Limousine Inc that it was not in compliance with the insurance requirements of 66 Pa.C.S. § 512. The Tentative Order advised Concorde Limousine Inc, that it must, within 30 days of publication of the Tentative Order, either have acceptable evidence of insurance filed with the Commission or cancel their authority or file comments to the Tentative Order. The Tentative Order advised Concorde Limousine Inc, that, if it failed to respond, its certificate of public convenience would be cancelled. The Tentative Order was served on Concorde Limousine Inc and published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.

Concorde Limousine Inc failed to respond to the September 15, 2021, Tentative Order and remains in non-compliance with the insurance requirements of the Public Utility Code at 66 Pa.C.S. § 512.
