

Please find attached Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 (this tariff cancels Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 5) for Eric Wright Enterprises, Inc. t/d/b/a Eric's Moving (PA PUC Certificate #A-00113409), P. O. Box 705, Royersford PA 19468. Changes are a **CHANGE** in verbiage to transportation between points in Pennsylvania as this company was granted statewide authority in May 2015, an **INCREASE** in flight charges for pianos, an **INCREASE** in the charge for handling of swing sets, a **CHANGE** in the application and an **INCREASE** in the cost of Full-Value Protection, an **INCREASE** in container rates, and an **INCREASE** in local hourly rates. SECTION 1  
RULES & REGULATIONS

**ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**▲ ITEM 20 - DECLARED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

**ITEM 30 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY**

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

**ITEM 40 - PACKING AND UNPACKING**

Packing and unpacking will be performed on an hourly basis plus the cost of containers (Item 200) and such labor will be charged for at labor rates shown in Section 3, Item 300.

**ITEM 50 - PIANO CARRY**

**ITEM 70 - FULL-VALUE PROTECTION**

Provisions of Rule 38 shown in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 50 issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent, and provisions of Rule 47 in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 51 issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent, apply except as provided herein.

▲ Provisions subject to a deductible of \$100.00

EXCEPTION: The rate for Full-Value Protection provided by carrier will be eighty-five (85) cents for each \$100.00 or fraction thereof while in possession of the motor carrier. Full-Value Protection is subject to a minimum of \$14,000.00 declared value per shipment.

SECTION 3  
HOURLY RATES

**ITEM 300**

Applicable to the transportation of CLASS 1 SHIPMENTS (Item 30) transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 and Note A below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, including any extra stops, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling from carrier's facility to first point of origin and traveling from final destination back to carrier's facility, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

NOTE 2 - Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) computed in full hours. Fractions of one hour considered as one hour.

NOTE 4 - Minimum total transportation charges: Sundays and Holidays (any hour): eight (8) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. Other than Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays (7:01AM to 5:00PM): five (5) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 3. Saturdays (any hour) and Weekdays (5:01PM to 7:00AM): five (5) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 4.

NOTE 5 - Rates in Column 4 apply only from 5:01PM to 12:00 midnight on any day when a higher rate is shown for the following day.

NOTE 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for a supervisor or supervisors as requested by shipper. Hourly rates for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal of supervisor is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.

NOTE A - Traveling charge shall be one (1) hour at applicable rates named in Columns 1 and Columns 2, 3 and 4 above.
