Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.591, Metropolitan Edison Company hereby files its report of Compliance. On February 4, 2021, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC”) entered a final order in the above-referenced proceeding. In that order, the PUC approved a settlement in the above-referenced case without modification. Pursuant to paragraph 41 of the settlement, Metropolitan Edison Company (“Met-Ed”) agreed to undertake several initiatives, with varying timelines for completion. On March 2, 2021, Met-Ed submitted its payment of the civil penalty required under paragraph 41(a), and on March 16, 2021, Met-Ed filed a compliance report advising that it had complied with the hardship fund contribution requirement as required under paragraph 41(b). This letter serves to report that since that time, Met-Ed has fully complied with the remedial measure commitments provided for under paragraph 41(c), (e), and (g) through (j). As of the date of this Compliance Report, Met-Ed’s implementation of the balance of the remedial measures, namely those provided for in paragraph 41(d) and (f), remains underway.
