The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PECO Energy Company's proposed Supplement No. 3 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 and the supporting rate computations submitted on January 31, 2022, and the replacement tariff pages submitted on February 18, 2022, to become effective on April 1, 2022.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Consumer Education Charge (CEC) rates for the twelve-month period of April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023, are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The CEC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).
