Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I am writing to inform you that CSXT has completed all of the Priority Code 0 items for which it is responsible pursuant to the March 30, 2020, McCormick Taylor Interim Bridge Inspection Report, pursuant to Recommended Ordering Paragraph 4 of the Recommended Decision, as adopted by Ordering Paragraph 2 of the Opinion and Order entered February 3, 2022, in this matter. Pursuant to the Inspection Report, CSXT was required to “[r]eplace the missing pedestrian railing at the near left corner and at mid-span of the right railing.” These repairs were completed by CSXT prior to the hearing in this matter on February 9, 2021. See CSXT Statement No. 1, pg. 4, lines 19-21. As shown on the attached photos taken on March 4, 2022, those repairs and all other pedestrian railings on the bridge are intact.

Please note that the other two Priority Code Zero repairs to be completed in the Inspection Report, namely to “[r]epair the approached sidewalk settlement and separations at each corner of the bridge” and to “[i]nstall an additional far advanced load posting on the right side of the roadway within 25’ marker’ of the Cemetery/Greenway/South 63<sup>rd</sup> Street intersection,” are the responsibility of the City of Philadelphia.
